

BECAUSE OF THEIR UNBELIEF

MARK 6:1-6

**Mark 6:1 And he went out from
thence, and came into his own
country; and his disciples
follow him.**

Mark 6:2 And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing him were astonished, saying, From whence hath this man these things? and what wisdom is this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

**Mark 6:3 Is not this the
carpenter, the son of Mary, the
brother of James, and Joses,
and of Juda, and Simon? and
are not his sisters here with
us? And they were offended at
him.**

**“Familiarity breeds contempt,
only with contemptible things
or among contemptible
people.” (Philips Brooks) The
contempt these people show
says more about them than it
does about Jesus. (Guzik)**

Mark 6:4 But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house.

**Mark 6:5 And he could there
do no mighty work, save that
he laid his hands upon a few
sick folk, and healed them.**

**Mark 6:6 And he marvelled
because of their unbelief. And
he went round about the
villages, teaching.**

**There are two times that
Scripture says Jesus Marveled:
Here, because of Jewish
unbelief and in Luke 7:9
because of the faith of a
Gentile.**

Luke 7:9 When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

Faith causes action!

**James 2:20 But wilt thou
know, O vain man, that faith
without works is dead?**
